Features: Two isolated areas, large private lounge with kitchen and restroom. The lounge can be integrated into the control room for flexibility.

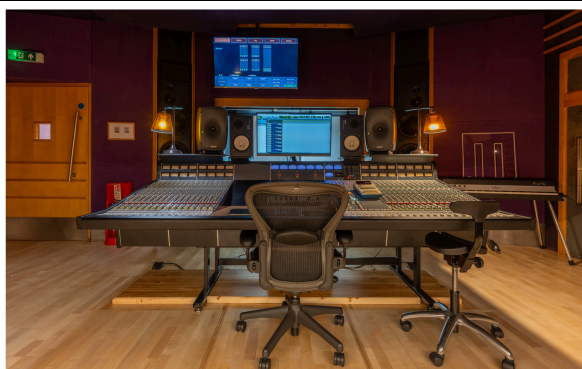


STUDIO C

The tracks were re-recorded at Metropolis Studios to fully utilize the immersive audio technology, providing listeners with a new way to experience his music.
